


Our ALD officers at Kent State's student organization fair at the beginning of the semester, recruiting and spreading word about ALD!

Thank you to all who attended the meeting tonight. Here is the recap of the meeting:


- Log points using the <u>point tracking form</u>, within 72 hours after the event.



- The team with the most points at the end of the semester will win an exclusive event with free food at the end of the semester!








We welcomed 448 new members during our annual induction ceremony, which was our largest induction class yet!


